CALL FOR SYMPOSIA

The IAYMH 2025 Programme Committee will be considering submissions for symposia at the IAYMH 2025 conference. Submissions will be assessed against the usual criteria for oral presentations, as well as some additional requirements listed below:

Symposia Guidelines

- There must be a common theme across all proposed presentations
- At the time of submission, all proposed presenters should be able to attend the conference in person.
- Each session should contain a minimum of 4 presentations and a maximum of 6
- Each session must have presenters currently based in least 2 geographic regions (e.g. Asia and North America)
- Each session must include at least 1 youth presenter (25 years or under *and not* an early career researcher) **and** 1 non-academic presenter (e.g. clinician)
- Submissions that include more than 1 youth and presenters from low to middle resource settings are strongly encouraged. Youth bursaries will be available for all youth attendees to apply for and there will be discounted registration rates for attendees from low and middle resource settings. However, symposia organisers are recommended to ensure, as best they can, the feasibility of all presenters being able to afford to attend the conference

How to submit a symposium proposal

- The Symposium co-ordinator must submit the Symposium details <u>here</u> using the Symposium Submission Form on the Oxford Abstracts Management system
- Only one person should submit for each overall Symposium using this form
- Each individual presenter should also submit their individual presentations using the standard abstract submission form, and should choose Symposium when asked to select their preferred presentation type.

Please note:

- If you are submitting an abstract that is to be considered as part of a Symposium, please do not submit the same abstract for consideration for a different presentation format (although you are welcome to submit different ones)
- Any unsuccessful symposia applications can be considered as individual submissions if the authors agree
